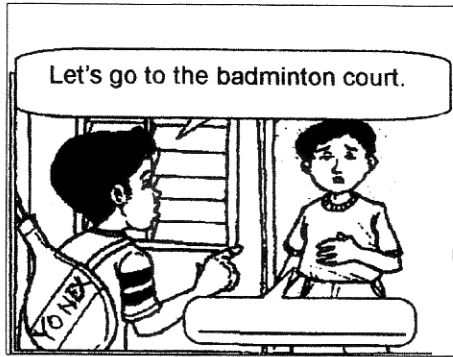

Flowers

There are many large flowers in the world such as the sunflower and the lotus. However, the world's largest flower is the *Rafflesia Arnoldii*. This rare flower is found in the rainforests of Indonesia. It can grow up to 100cm across and weigh up to about 7 kilograms! It is a parasite plant. The leaves, roots and stem are not seen. It attaches itself to a host plant to obtain water and nutrients. When in bloom, the *Rafflesia* produces a bad odour, similar to that of rotting meat. This odour attracts insects that pollinate the plant.

Another **enormous** flower found in Indonesia is the *Titan Arum*. It is also known as the 'corpse flower' for its unpleasant odour. Like the *Rafflesia*, the *Titan* produces the smell of rotting flesh to attract pollinators. The *Titan arum* is not a single flower. It is a cluster of many tiny flowers. The plant can reach heights of about 4metres and weigh as much as 70 kilograms!
